Lieutenant Governor of Nova Scotia in Council made the

The Governor in Council on the recommendation of the President of the Executive Council dated the 25th day of November, A.D. 1965 and pursuant to the Scott Maritimes Pulp Limited Agreement Act, 1965, and for the purpose of implementing an obligation assumed by the Province under an agreement entered into between the Province and Scott Maritimes Pulp Limited to supply fresh water to the mill of the said company, is pleased to:


- (a) ratify and confirm the designation of the Nova Scotia Power Commission and designate the said Commission as an agent of the Province to build a dam across Middle River in the County of Pictou;
- (b) direct the Department of Highways to so construct a causeway across Pictou Harbour in the County of Pictou as to constitute it an impervious dam to provide for a water level of plus twelve;
- (c) direct the Nova Scotia Water Authority
 - (i) to provide all facilities necessary for the delivery of water from the reservoir created by the Middle River dam and the reservoir created by the Pictou Harbour Causeway dam, or either of them, to the mill of the said company;
 - (ii) to acquire all land required by it to provide the facilities referred to in sub-clause (i) and deal with all claims arising or which may arise from flooding as a result of the construction of the Middle River dam;

the Middle River dam;

(d) authorize the Minister of Finance and Economics

(i) to pay accounts certified by the Nova Scotia Power Commission as expenses properly incurred by it under clause (a);

- (ii) to pay accounts certified by the Department of Highways and the Nova Scotia Water Authority as expenses properly incurred by the Department of Highways under clause (b) in excess of amounts properly chargeable to Trans-Canada Highway construction;
- (iii) to pay accounts certified by the Nova Scotia Water Authority as expenses properly incurred by it under clause (c).
